

## Radian Quad band:

**Stacked** (Modified Canon  
6D; TeleVue 5" refractor, f/5.2;  
fl 660mm)

*NGC 3372, ASSA 44 + Eta Carina Nebula: Contains the star Eta Carina (with the "Homunculus nebula"); several open clusters, the Keyhole nebula - visible in this image +/- in centre. The Eta Carina nebula surrounds the massive stars Eta Carinae and HD 93129A, as well as several open star clusters. It is one of the largest diffuse nebulae known, being brighter and four times the size of the Orion Nebula.*
